Regular Civil Suit No. 19/2014 is one of the suit from the above settled matters, which was pending before the Junior Civil Judge, Sanguem and has been settled by filing consent terms by both the parties. The suit was filed in the year 2014 for Permanent injunction was referred for the National Lok Adalat on 09.09.2017. Both the parties settled the issue by demarcating the plot of the defendants and constructed the compound wall and boundary line. The Plaintiffs and the defendants decided not to interfere with the property of each other and to peacefully enjoy their rights. The defendants admitted that they have no rights to remaining area other than that the demarcated plot of the defendants and the Plaintiffs admitted that they have no right in the plot demarcated and separated by the compound wall of the defendants.
